SHADE HANGAR GUTTERS

Cleaning and caulking of gutters on all shade hangars has been completed by Airport Operations Staff. If you see a leak or a gutter running over at any shade hangar, please notify the Airport Office at 253-4300.

POSTED SPEED LIMIT 10 MPH

The posted speed limit on Airport ramps is 10 MPH. Parking lot and Airport Road to the hangar area are posted 20 MPH. Speed to the tower on Airport Road is posted 30 MPH. *Please do not exceed the posted limit.*

FUTURE FLY-A-LEADER EVENTS

GATE USE

Gates 1 and 2 are designated for Emergency and County Vehicle use only. Gate 3 is for Bridgeford Flying Services use only. Tenants please use Gates 4-7 to access the hangars and south ramp.

Please do not give out key pad or remote codes to non-tenants. Non-tenants requesting access to the gated areas should register at the Airport office to receive a temporary code.

Thanks to our tenants, for confining vehicle traffic to Gates 4-7 and the hangar area. We appreciate your help in keeping the Airport safe.

COMPRESSOR USE IN HANGARS

As a courtesy to other tenants, please be sure to unplug your compressor when you leave your hangar. This saves energy and eardrums.

GARBAGE REMINDER

As a reminder, garbage cans provided on the Airport are for *Airport generated garbage only*. Please bag your trash.

FAA RE-REGISTRATION SCHEDULE

The FAA re-registration schedule has been posted at the south ramp restrooms and bulletin boards in the terminal building.

The Federal Aviation Administration has established the requirement to re-register all aircraft issued registration before October 1, 2010. Aircraft register on or after October 1, 2010 will expire after three years, requiring renewal.

Notice will be sent to the registered owner(s) at the registration address of record six months before expiration to announce the re-registration window for the aircraft, provide instructions and direct the owner(s) to <http://registry.faa.gov/renewregistration> to apply for aircraft re-registration.

If the aircraft ownership, citizenship and registration address shown in the FAA system are correct, application may be filed and paid on line. If the address needs updating or the aircraft has been sold or removed from service, these changes may be entered on the form, printed, signed and mailed to the FAA Aircraft Registry with any applicable fees.
