PEDESTRIAN GATE CODES HAVE CHANGED

Codes for pedestrian gates with key pads have changed. **For your security and the security of others, please do not share any gate code information with others.**

HANGAR SECURITY

When closing your hangar doors, please be sure they are securely locked. For those hangars with door pins, be sure they are set correctly to avoid the doors sliding out of place.

AIRCRAFT WASHING

This is a reminder. It has been reported that some tenants are not using the wash rack, which is correctly equipped with an oil/water separator, for aircraft washing. **The wash rack is the only designated area for aircraft washing.** Please remember, private vehicle washing is not permitted anywhere on the airport.

Expect increased aircraft and pedestrian activity. Tenants, please avoid driving in any area other than the apron around the hangars.

The self-service fuel station will remain open during the event.
