## **FLIGHT LINE APRIL 2010**

### **GATE 4 – 7 CODES CHANGE APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup>**

In an effort to maintain security for the tenants of Napa County Airport, vehicle gate codes are changed annually and remote control codes are changes every two years. On Thursday, April 15, 2010, gate codes and remote control codes for Gates 4-7 will change. Key pad codes for delivery vehicles will also be changed.

The new code and remote clicker sequences will be included in tenant's monthly billing statement for April. If you do not receive a letter, come to the Airport Office for more information. The codes will be available to tenants only.

You may bring your remote clicker to the Airport Office for reprogramming. The office is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. - noon and 1:00 – 5:00 p.m., closed on holidays.

### **GATE REMOTES AVAILABLE**

Gate remote clickers are now available to tenants only, for a fee of \$25.00. Clickers are programmed to open gates 4 – 7. To purchase a clicker, visit the Airport Office during business hours.

### **TENANT AIRCRAFT PARKING ON THE SOUTH RAMP**

Airport hangar tenants who need to park their aircraft on the South ramp overnight will incur a transient parking fee unless the Airport office is notified in advance.

Please notify the Airport office at 707-253-4300 with the N-number of the aircraft and the time frame that they aircraft will be on the ramp to avoid overnight fees.

### **EAA B-17 COMING IN MAY**

Napa's Chapter 167 of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) announces the arrival of the EAA's B-17, Aluminum Overcast. This beautiful, timeless aircraft will be at Napa County Airport in early May. The plane is set to arrive in the afternoon of Thursday, May 6th and depart on Monday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. The aircraft will be open for public viewing and daily flights are scheduled.

### **AIRCRAFT WASHING**

This is a reminder that tenants are required to use the wash rack, which is properly equipped with an oil/water separator, for aircraft washing.

The wash rack is the only designated area for aircraft washing which complies with the Airport's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). The Airport is required to have and maintain an up-to-date SWPPP in order to comply with State Water Resources Control Board water quality regulations and the Federal Clean Water Act.

The efforts of all tenants to help keep local waterways clean by using the designated washing area are greatly appreciated. Please remember that private vehicle washing is not permitted anywhere on the airport.

### **HANGAR UPDATE**
