You may bring your remote clicker to the Airport Office for reprogramming. The office is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. - noon and 1:00 - 5:00 p.m., closed on holidays.

### **HANGAR INSPECTION QUESTIONS**

There have been questions regarding some safety regulations in the hangars. This is our current information from the Fire Marshal.

- You can have the ability to store a maximum of ten (10) gallons of gas (containers can be empty or full) in the hangar.
- There can be one, five gallon propane bottle (empty or full) in the hangar.
- Surge protectors must be plugged directly into receptacles.
- Refrigerators must be plugged directly into receptacles.
- Extension cords must be unplugged from receptacles when leaving the hangar.

### **REMOTE GATE CLICKERS AVAILABLE**

Gate remote clickers are now available to tenants for a fee of \$25.00. Clickers are programmed to open gates 4 - 7. To purchase a clicker, visit the Airport Office during business hours.
