NASCAR WEEKEND JUNE 18TH -20TH

As a reminder, the NASCAR Sprint Cup race at Infineon Raceway in Sonoma is Father's Day weekend. Please expect increased aircraft and helicopter activity Thursday, June 17th through Sunday, June 20th. The Napa County Sheriff's Department, Posse and Aero Squadron will provide security and direct traffic on race day, Sunday June 20th.

For everyone's safety, please limit driving to areas around the hangars during the event. *On Sunday, June 20th, the self-service fuel station will be closed. Fuel will be available from the trucks at self-service prices.*

HANGAR SECURITY

When closing your hangar doors, please be sure they are securely locked. For those hangars with door pins, be sure they are set correctly to avoid the doors sliding out of place.

TENANTS PLEASE USE GATE 4 – 7 FOR HANGAR ACCESS

Tenants, please use Gates 4-7 to access the hangar area. Gate 3 is to be used by FBO customers only. With the upcoming summer events and numerous summer visitors who may be unfamiliar with the airport layout, please limit driving to the area around your hangars.

GATE REMOTES AVAILABLE

Gate remote clickers are now available to tenants for a fee of \$25.00. Clickers are programmed to open gates 4 – 7. To purchase a clicker, visit the Airport Office during business hours.



WINGS OF FREEDOM TOUR AT NAPA COUNTY AIRPORT JUNE 9TH – 11TH

The Collings Foundation's Wings of Freedom Tour will visit Napa County Airport June 9th – 11th. The aircraft that will be on display and available for flights are a B-17G Flying Fortress, a B-24J Liberator, and a P-51 Mustang. The planes will arrive about 2:00 P.M. on June 9th and depart about 1:00 P.M. on June 11th. The aircraft will be open for public viewing and daily flights are scheduled. AIRCRAFT WASHING

As a reminder, in order to comply with the Airport's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Program, all aircraft must be washed in an area equipped with an oil/water separator. At Napa County Airport, the only location that meets this requirement is the wash rack located on the south ramp next to Gate 7. **The wash rack is the only designated area for aircraft washing.**

GATE CODE CHANGE REMINDER

On April 15th, tenant key pad codes and gate remote control codes for Gates 4-7 were changed. Key pad codes for delivery vehicles were also changed.

If you need help to reset your gate remote, come to the Airport Office for more information. The office is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. - noon and 1:00 – 5:00 p.m., closed on holidays. The codes are available to tenants only. **For your security and the security of others, please do not share the gate code information with others.**
