## PROJECT UPDATES

### BOX HANGARS

The foundation work for the Erect-A-Tube hangar project, which consists of construction of eight box hangars, has been completed. There are large trucks and equipment in the vicinity of Gate 6 and Gate 7. Please use caution.

### GATE 6 TEMPORARILY CLOSED

Due to heavy equipment working at close proximity, Gate 6 will likely remain closed until the box hangars are completed. Please use Gate 4 or Gate 7.

### HANGAR DOOR REPAIR

Door repairs on hangars 25 through 36 will continue through the winter months.

### EXECUTIVE HANGARS UPDATE

Three executive hangars are taking shape on the south side of Taxiway Juliet. Las Madronas hangar now has a temporary occupancy permit! Neives' hangar and Tallwood Two, which will house their Global Express, are progressing quickly.

### WASH RACK

The slab has been poured for a new aircraft wash rack, just south of Gate 7. Other systems are still being installed.

For vehicle washing, please use only the wash racks provided. (The current wash rack is south of Bridgeford's FBO). As the Airport is on a major watershed, we ask that you do not wash your vehicles in other locations. This is for your safety and to help keep our water clean.

### T-HANGARS

New T-Hangars, suitable for single engine and light twin aircraft are in the planning stages for 2007.

### GLIDE SLOPE

The Glide Slope is scheduled for completion in 2007.

## CUSTOMER SERVICE

### BATTERY RE-CYCLE

Please do not throw your batteries in the trash! All types of batteries can be re-cycled at the blue re-cycle bin next to the oil waste dump on the South ramp.

## SAFETY & SECURITY

### GROUND VEHICLE SPEED LIMITS

The Security Advisory Committee is currently analyzing ground vehicle speed issues on the Airport.

As the first step, Airport Road has been properly posted with 20 mph, 30 mph and corner markers.

Additional 10 mph signs have been installed on the airside.

Gate 1 and Gate 2 are posted **"EMERGENCY & COUNTY VEHICLES ONLY."** Tenants and visitors are asked to use Gates 3, 4 and 7 only.

### SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS

Phase One of the Airport's camera system, which includes three cameras, is now complete. The system has the capability to store images for future reference. Cameras can be monitored at the Airport and the Sheriff's Station.

### PARKING LOT LIGHTING

Two of the new lights are now functional. This improves lighting conditions at the bridge and main parking lot.

**FLY – A – LEADER** resumes this summer with four Fly-A-Leader events, jointly sponsored by the Airport, Bridgeford Flying Services, JAL/IASCO, CHP, Jonesy's Famous Steakhouse, Napa Chamber of Commerce and the Napa Airport Pilots' Association.

**AIRPORT DAY OPEN HOUSE** is tentatively planned for Labor Day Weekend on Saturday, September 1<sup>st</sup>. This will be a joint effort of the EAA and NAPA.

## HANGAR INSPECTIONS

Operations Staff is currently inspecting hangars for safety infractions and mechanical problems. Potential safety hazards they encounter include extension cords left plugged into receptacles, refrigerators not plugged directly to receptacles, uncovered trash and rags, oil and other fluids on floors under aircraft and storage of unauthorized (especially flammable and rodent attractant items).

Drip pans, non-flammable rag containers and trash cans are readily available at local auto centers and hardware stores.
