PROJECT UPDATES

RUNWAY 18R/36L REHAB

The runway rehabilitation project for 18R/36L is still in negotiations.

BOX HANGARS

Work on the eight hangar Erect-A-Tube project continues. The steel for the structures is on site and is currently being assembled.

GATE 6 CLOSED, CONSTRUCTION DETOURS

DUE TO PERSONNEL AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT WORKING IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO GATE 7, PLEASE USE EXTREME CAUTION WHEN DRIVING YOUR VEHICLE OR TAXIING YOUR AIRCRAFT IN THIS VICINITY. THERE MAY BE TEMPORARY DETOURS IN THIS AREA.

HANGAR DOOR REPAIR

Door repairs on hangars 13 through 24 have been completed.

EXECUTIVE HANGARS UPDATE

Three executive hangars are taking shape on the south side of Taxiway Juliet. Las Madronas and Nieves' hangars are complete. Tallwood Two, which will house their Global Express, is nearing completion. Apron paving has been completed.

WASH RACK

The new aircraft wash rack is nearing completion. The slab has been poured and other systems are still being installed.

For vehicle washing, please use only the wash racks provided. (The current wash rack is south of Bridgeford's FBO). As the Airport is on a major watershed, we ask that you do not wash your vehicles in other locations. This is for your safety and to help keep our water clean.

FUTURE PROJECTS

T-HANGARS

New T-Hangars, suitable for single engine and light twin aircraft are still in the planning stages.

GLIDE SLOPE

Due to environmental issues, the Glide Slope completion schedule has been delayed.

SAFETY & SECURITY

GROUND VEHICLE SPEED LIMITS

The safety of all our tenants, aircraft, businesses and employees is a major concern. The Security Advisory Committee is currently working to improve ground vehicle speed and aircraft taxi issues on the Airport.

Airport Road has been properly posted with 20 mph, 30 mph and corner markers.

Additional 10 mph signs and CAUTION signs have been installed on the airside. NO PARKING

markings have been painted on the center apron adjacent to the main intersection.

Gate 1 and Gate 2 are posted **"EMERGENCY & COUNTY VEHICLES ONLY."** Additionally, red CAUTION markings have been painted around Gate 2 and the Airport Operations facility to increase safety for taxing aircraft near the self-service fuel station. *TENANTS AND VISITORS ARE TO USE GATES 3, 4 AND 7 ONLY.*

As our busy season gears up, Airport Operations asks the cooperation of all tenants on the Airport. Please travel at safe speed, on the ramp, Airport Road and in the parking lots. Be especially cautious when driving or taxiing near the south ramp intersection.

SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS

The Airport's camera system which includes three cameras, is up and running. The system is monitored at the Airport and also archives images for future viewing. The Sheriff's Station also has the capability to monitor the system.

NEW TERMINOLOGY FOR TAXILANE JULIET

To avoid confusion, FAA Air Traffic Manager, Chief, Jeff Osborne has requested that aircraft taxiing on Juliet to the Executive hangars request taxi to the EXECUTIVE RAMP. The controllers thank you for your help.
