## AIRPORT SECURITY

### GATE CODES

All Airport gate codes were changed as of April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Both the key pads and gate remote clicker codes have changed. The new code for hangar tenants provides access to the South ramp through gates 4, 5, 6 and 7. If you need help programming your gate remote clicker, or do not know the current key pad code, please come to the Airport Office. We will be happy to assist you.

*The gate code information is confidential, for tenant use only. New codes will be issued only to known tenants. In the interest of safety, please do not share your access code with anyone who is not a tenant.*

All non-tenants are asked to check in at the Airport Office. There are special codes for non-tenants seeking access to the Airside. These codes are available on a daily basis from the Airport Office.

### GATE SAFETY

When approaching a closing gate, please wait for the cycle to be completed, then enter your gate code or use your remote clicker.

*Please do not "tailgate" through an open gate, as the gate may close on your car!*

## HANGAR SAFETY

### NO SMOKING SIGN

If you still need a **NO SMOKING** sign or a hangar information packet, they are available at the Airport office.

California Fire Code section 1103.2 requires **NO SMOKING** signs be posted in hangars.

### AIRCRAFT FUELING

The California Fire Code, section 1106.17.1- Position of Aircraft states: ***"Aircraft being fueled shall be positioned such that any fuel system vents and other fuel tank openings are a minimum of 25 feet from buildings or structures."***

Based on current code, there can be no fueling of aircraft inside the hangars or shade hangars. Thank you for your cooperation in moving your aircraft outside of your hangar for fueling.

## PROJECT UPDATES

Installation of electrical conduit on the west side of Runway 18R/36L has been completed. Thanks to all our tenants for their patience during the week long process. This will ultimately serve the future glideslope and PAPI.

## MASTER PLAN

On April 15<sup>th</sup>, the Airport Master Plan Update, along with supporting State and Federal environmental documents, was approved by the Napa County Board of Supervisors.

## ROAD & PARKING LOT MAINTENANCE

Overlay of Airport Road from the Fagan Creek Bridge to the Bridgeford Executive Terminal Building (Gate 3) has been completed.

## UPCOMING AIRPORT EVENTS

### NASCAR AT INFINEON JUNE 22<sup>ND</sup>

NASCAR preparations begin June 16<sup>th</sup> and culminate with the race at Infineon on Sunday, June 22<sup>ND</sup>. On that day, there will be numerous helicopter shuttles to and from Infineon Raceway.

On Sunday, all vehicle traffic will be stopped at parking lot and directed to the proper area by Sheriff's Aero Squadron or Airport Operations staff. Airport tenants going to their hangars will be directed through Gate 4.

The north parking lot will be used for rental car and helicopter passenger parking only.

The terminal building parking lot will be restricted to Jonesy's and terminal parking.

Beginning on Wednesday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, smaller transient aircraft will be parked on the south ramp.

***Tenants should not drive vehicles on the ramp during NASCAR week. PLEASE RESTRICT DRIVING TO THE HANGAR AREA ONLY.***
