PROJECT UPDATES

WORK CONTINUES ON JULIET

The soil has officially dried enough for crews to work and Ghilotti Brothers Construction has returned to the Airport. Two taxi lanes and an access road on Juliet are under construction.

During construction, please use extra caution driving on Airport Road due to truck traffic and heavy equipment at work.

HANGAR TRACK REPAIR

Door track repairs on hangars 25 through 36 are planned for 2006-2007. Work should begin by autumn of 2006.
