PROJECT UPDATES

NEW TAXI LANES ON JULIET

In June, work will soon resume on Airport Improvement Project (AIP20) which includes taxi lanes on taxiway Juliet.

HANGAR TRACK REPAIR

Vortex continues to repair hangars. The yearly hangar door inspection and maintenance has been completed. If you notice an operational problem, please inform Airport Operations at 707.253.4301 or 299.1695.

Lower track for hangars 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 have been replaced. Work on this phase of hangar refurbishment is nearing completion.

Lower track repairs on hangars 25 through 36 are planned for 2006-2007. Work should begin by autumn of 2006.

HANGAR ROOF REHABILITATION

TERMINAL BUILDING PROJECTS

New, modular seating for the lobby has been ordered. Thanks to Bridgeford Flying Services for their donation of a coffee table and small sofa.

Automatic doors which are ADA compliant will be installed at the north end of the entry foyer on June 12th.

The exit door to the west foyer has been converted to an automatic ADA compliant door. Inside the lobby, there is an automatic opener on the post near the door.

The new ceiling, with energy efficient lighting has been installed in the lobby area.

The lobby and hallway are currently being painted.
