PROJECT UPDATES

NEW TAXI LANES ON JULIET

Work will resume on Airport Improvement Project (AIP20) in spring of 2006. The project includes new taxi lanes and a new access road for taxiway Juliet. Ghilotti Bros. is currently hauling fill dirt for the project, which is being deposited along Airport Tower Road.

HANGAR TRACKS H013 – H023

Vortex will continue to repair hangars during the coming months. As a test case, lower replacement track was fabricated and installed in Hangar 24. The doors are now working smoothly.

Lower track for hangars 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 is now being fabricated and will be installed this spring.

HANGAR ROOF REHABILITATION

Ongoing hangar refurbishment projects include re-roofing hangars H013 – H036. The bidding process for this work is complete, with an estimated start date in March, 2006.

Tenants should consider covering aircraft left inside the hangars during the roofing project. Florescent tube lights need to be removed from ceiling fixtures. Tenants in these hangars will be notified in advance of the work.

GATE REPAIR

Fence and gate repair will continue this winter. Gate 5 and Gate 6 are now functioning properly.

GLIDE SLOPE STILL ON SCHEDULE

Glide Slope installation is still on schedule, with commissioning set for October-November, 2006. The obstruction survey for the instrument landing system has been completed.

ROAD REPAIRS

Potholes on Airport Blvd. and Airport Road have been patched.

GATE IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM

All automatic gates are now labeled with numbers. Manual gates are labeled with letters. You can report a gate out of order by contacting the Airport Office staff. Indicate the number or letter of the malfunctioning gate and describe the problem.
