PROJECT UPDATES

NEW TAXI LANES ON JULIET

Work will resume on Airport Improvement Project (AIP20) in spring of 2006. We are still on hold due to ground saturation.

HANGAR TRACK REPAIR

Vortex will continue to repair hangars during the coming months. Yearly hangar door inspection and maintenance will begin soon.

Lower track for hangars 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 has been fabricated and is currently stored in the hangars where it will be installed. This should take place later this spring. Upper track work on these hangars has been completed. All track work on hangar 24 is complete.

Lower track repairs on hangars 25 through 36 should take place in late summer 2006.

HANGAR ROOF REHABILITATION

Roof rehabilitation on hangars 13 – 36 has been completed. Thanks to the cooperation of our great tenants, an efficient crew from Western Roofing and help from Bridgeford Flying Services, Project Supervisor Ron Critchley and our Operations staff, the project went smoothly, despite rain delays.

TERMINAL BUILDING PROJECTS

New automatic doors which are ADA compliant will be installed at the north end of the entry foyer. The exit door to the west foyer will be converted to an automatic ADA compliant door.

New ceiling and more energy efficient lighting are coming soon to the lobby area.

A new projection screen and overhead projector tray have been installed in the conference room.

SAFETY & SECURITY

The EAA and the Collings Foundation will visit APC with their "War Birds", during May. Visitors to the Airport will access the aircraft displays only through the terminal lobby. There will be escorts to assure visitors stay within the display area.

For these events, the display aircraft will be parked north of the main intersection, on the taxi lane adjacent to the fence.

Tenants, please stay clear of the display area on the ramp side. If you wish to view the aircraft, enter through the terminal lobby.

If you wish to use the self-service fuel station during the events, taxi north on the outer taxi lane and approach the self-service fuel area from the north. Please do not try to access the fuel station from the main intersection.
