## AIRPORT SECURITY

### GATE CODES

All Airport gate codes have been changed as of Tuesday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Both the key pads and gate remote clicker codes have changed. A notice of the change was enclosed with the April hangar rent billing.

The new code for hangar tenants provides access to the South ramp through gates 4, 5, 6 and 7.

**All non-tenants are asked to check in at the Airport Office.** There are special codes for non-tenants seeking access to the Airside. These codes are available on a daily basis from the Airport Office.

If you do not wish to re-program your own remote clicker, bring it to the Airport office, Monday – Friday, 8 A.M. – Noon and 1 – 5 p.m. We will be glad to assist you.

We thank you for helping to make a smooth transition to the new codes. Please call Airport Operations at 707-299-1695 or the Airport Office at 707-253-4300 if you have questions regarding the gate codes.

***The gate code information is confidential, for tenant use only. New codes will be issued only to known tenants. In the interest of safety, please do not share your access code with anyone who is not a tenant.***

### GATE SAFETY

Gate timing will be reset soon. When approaching a closing gate, please wait for the cycle to be completed, then enter your gate code or use your remote clicker.

***Please do not "tailgate" through an open gate, as the gate may close on your car!***

## HANGAR SAFETY

### HANGAR RE-INSPECTIONS

Re-inspection of hangars has been completed. We are pleased to report the safety aspects and general condition of hangars is greatly improved thanks to great work by our tenants.

### NO SMOKING SIGN

If you still need a **NO SMOKING** sign or a hangar information packet, they are available at the Airport office.

California Fire Code section 1103.2 requires **NO SMOKING** signs be posted in hangars.

## AIRCRAFT FUELING

Recently, we have been made aware of tenant requests for aircraft fueling inside the hangars. The California Fire Code, section 1106.17.1- Position of Aircraft states: ***"Aircraft being fueled shall be positioned such that any fuel system vents and other fuel tank openings are a minimum of 25 feet from buildings or structures."***

Based on current code, there can be no fueling of aircraft inside the hangars or shade hangars. Thank you for your cooperation in moving your aircraft outside of your hangar for fueling.

## PROJECT UPDATES

Spring construction is already in progress with electrical conduit being installed across the North ramp.

### RUNWAY CLOSURES IN MAY

**Runway 18R/36L will be closed Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup> – Friday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>** to resolve a pavement issue from previous construction. At the same time, electrical conduit will be installed. This will ultimately serve the future glideslope and PAPI.

### AIRPORT CLOSURE

**The Airport will be closed at 10:00 PM on May 21<sup>st</sup> and will re-open at 6:00 AM on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.** No flights will be cleared to land or depart KAPC during the closure.

### MASTER PLAN

On April 15<sup>th</sup>, the Airport Master Plan Update, along with supporting State and Federal environmental documents, was approved by the Napa County Board of Supervisors.

### ROAD & PARKING LOT MAINTENANCE

Expect further pavement maintenance activity on the road and parking lot at the terminal building. Plans are being made to complete the overlay of the road, from JAL to the Bridgeford Executive Terminal Building, sometime in May.
