## HISTORY OF THE AIRPORT

The airport was originally constructed by the U.S. military during World War II. Now owned and operated by Napa County, it has been improved over the years with control tower, instrumentation, runway lights, and other improvements and is now considered one of the finest general aviation airports in the greater Bay Area. Japan Air Lines maintains a multimillion dollar airline pilot training facility at the airport.

## THE FUTURE OF THE AIRPORT

Future development of the industrial-zoned land adjacent to the airport will see greater corporate use of its facilities. Napa County and the FAA have programed over \$20 million into airport improvements including new hangars and fuel facilities.

## CLIMATE

Strongly influenced by the built-in air conditioning of San Francisco Bay, Napa County enjoys a smog-free climate of moderation. Representative minimum and maximum temperatures for the City of Napa for January are 37.4 degrees minimum and 57.7 degrees maximum. For July they are 52.2 degrees and 82.1 degrees, respectively. Average annual rainfall for Napa is 23.88 inches with the majority occurring from November thru March.

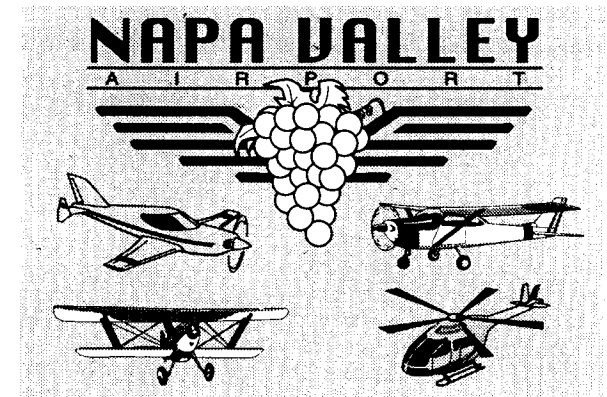
## INDUSTRY

While known worldwide for agriculture, Napa County welcomes clean industry. Near the airport are several industrial parks with all utilities. Others are under construction. Land for industrial development surrounds the airport.

## TRANSPORTATION

In addition to the airport's excellent facilities, rail, truck and bus transportation are available. Water transport via the Napa River is also a possibility. Interstate 80, which links Sacramento with San Francisco, is close by and State Highways 12, 29 and 121, which transit Napa County, are all close to the airport.

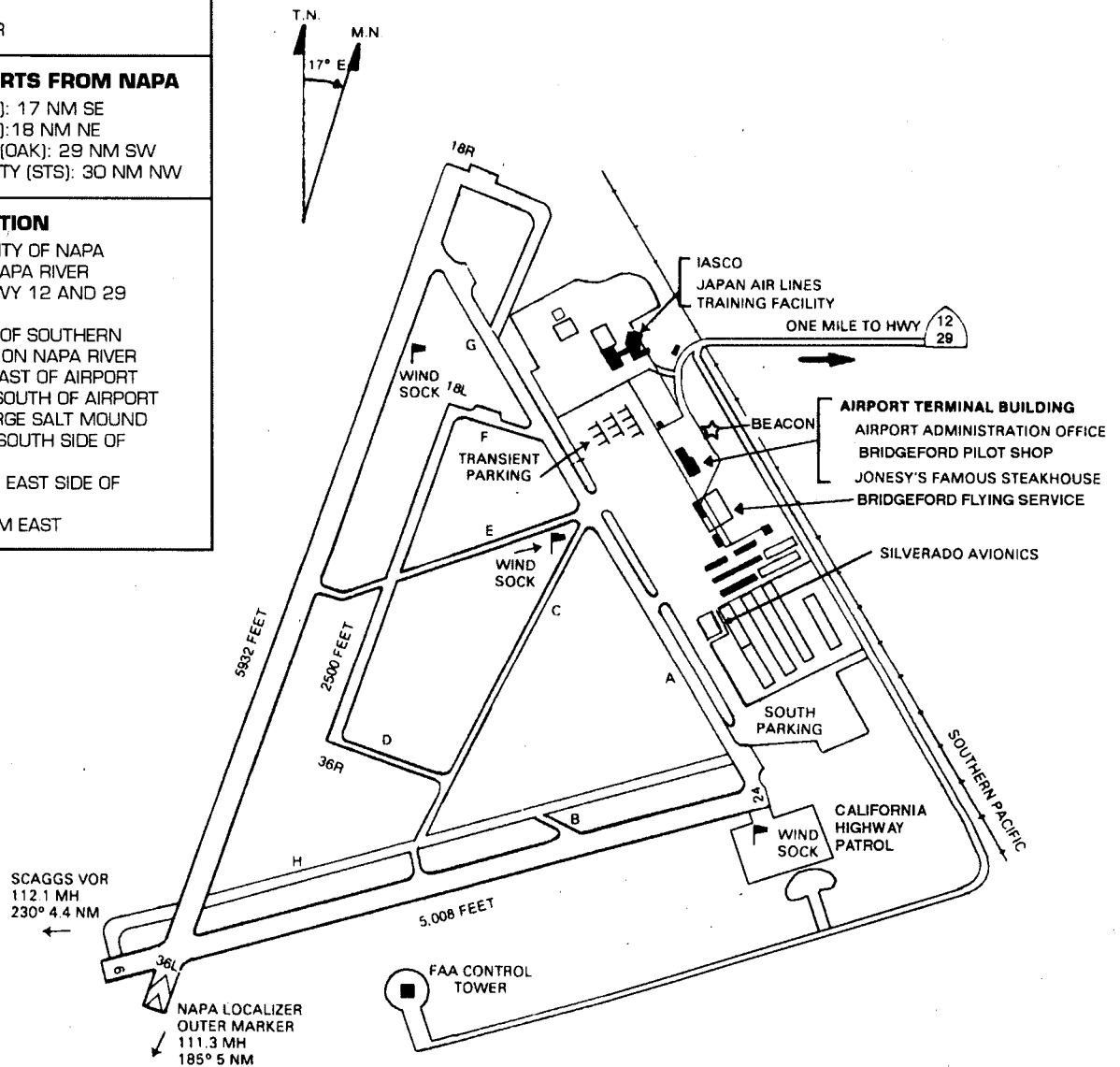
